

Habitat's Critical Home Repair (CHR) Program focuses primarily on repair and/or rehab projects that will improve the quality of life for the homeowner and provide a decent home in which to live.

This program can revitalize the appearance of a neighborhood, encourage connections within the community, and help preserve affordable housing stock.

## **REPAIRS WE MAKE**

## Our Critical Home Repair Program focuses on services that may include:

- Door replacement
- Accessibility ramps
- Minor exterior repairs to siding or trim
- Steps/Handrail replacement for safety
- Single story, shallow sloped roofs and soffit/fascia replacement
- · Minor electrical or plumbing repairs
- Energy efficiency projects/insulation

#### Projects that do not qualify include:

- · Aesthetic home improvements
- Beautification projects
- Landscaping
- · Detached garages
- Second story or steep pitched roofs
- Projects that exceed \$5,000
- · Window replacement

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Habitat's Critical Home Repair Program is for low-income households, the elderly, veterans, and people living with disabilities based on need and scope of work.

### **PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

- Applicant must own and occupy the home that needs repairs for a minimum of 2 years.
- Home must be in Washington or Dodge County and be covered by current homeowner's insurance.
- Applicant must earn between 30% and 50% of the county's median income for family size. (see our website for income guidelines)
- Homeowners agree to repay a 0% interest loan for materials and professional services used for the repair.
- Applicant should be willing to partner with Habitat by participating in the repair project as they are able.
